

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is very important to us. Accordingly, we have developed this Policy in order for you to understand how we collect, use, communicate and disclose and make use of personal information. The following outlines our privacy policy.

- We collect personal information for the purpose of registering students and staff for competitions, camps, and classes. If you are entering information for persons other than yourself, you are responsible for obtaining the appropriate consents.
- We will collect and use personal information solely with the objective of fulfilling those purposes specified by us and for other compatible purposes, unless we obtain the consent of the individual concerned or as required by law.
- We collect your phone number and message content solely for the purpose of delivering our services. We do not share or sell your information to third parties.
- We will protect personal information by reasonable security safeguards against loss or theft, as well as unauthorized access, disclosure, copying, use or modification.
- We will make readily available to customers information about our policies and practices relating to the management of personal information.

We are committed to conducting our business in accordance with these principles in order to ensure that the confidentiality of personal information is protected and maintained.

Refunds/Cancellations

1. No Refunds will be offered for a No-Show or Scratch at a competition regardless of the circumstance. Any payment made by you will be retained by The All Star Cheerleading Championships as damages to pay for the costs and expenses that The All Star Cheerleading Championships incurs in such cancellation.

If a program withdraws a team or multiple teams within two weeks (14 days) of a scheduled event, the program will receive a 50% credit toward a future event. This credit is applicable regardless of the reason for the withdrawal, which includes, but is not limited to, athlete or coach sickness, injury, or absence. This policy helps us manage event logistics and costs that are committed in advance, such as venue fees, staffing, and awards. To be eligible for the 50% credit, all cancellations must be formally submitted in writing. The program's primary contact must send an email to Registration@TheAllstarCheerleadingChampionships.com prior to the scheduled check-in time for each affected team. The email must clearly state the name of the program, the event name, and the specific team(s) being withdrawn. The 50% credit will be applied to the program's account and can be used for any future event registration with The Allstar Cheerleading Championships. This credit has no expiration date and can be applied at any time to a future event registration fee. The credit holds no cash value and cannot be exchanged for a refund.

2. All final decisions regarding scoring will be determined at the event. The Allstar Cheerleading Championships will review and make the final determination regarding all results. There are no refunds for disputes, unsatisfactory results or outcome from an event.

3.. Any hotel reservations made through The All Star Cheerleading Championships or its affiliates are non refundable and non-transferable.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Our top priority is the safety and well-being of all participants, coaches, staff, and spectators. In the event of inclement weather, The Allstar Cheerleading Championships reserves the right to make decisions regarding the event schedule, including delays, modifications, or cancellation.

If The Allstar Cheerleading Championships determines that the event can proceed safely, but a program is unable to attend due to localized inclement weather in their area (e.g., snowstorm, flooding, road closures), that program will receive a 60% credit toward a future event. The credit has no expiration date and can be applied at any time. The credit holds no cash value and cannot be exchanged for a refund. This policy is in place to account for costs already incurred by The Allstar Cheerleading Championships in the production of the event, such as venue fees, staff, and other operational expenses. If the facility is open, the event will go on. Ultimately, the decision to travel and attend the event is at the discretion of the individual program. While we will make every effort to provide a safe environment, programs should assess their own local travel conditions before departing. The Allstar Cheerleading Championships assumes no responsibility for any costs incurred by programs, including but not limited to travel, lodging, or other expenses, in the event of a cancellation, delay, or if a program chooses not to attend due to weather. The Allstar Cheerleading Championships will work with programs who may be delayed due to weather and road conditions. The program's primary contact must contact the event coordinator either by email, text or call prior to the report time.

It is rare that the All Star Cheerleading Championships cancels an event. However, if The All Star Cheerleading Championships is forced to cancel the entire event due to severe and widespread inclement weather (e.g., a state of emergency, a named storm, or a weather event that makes the venue and travel unsafe for the majority of participants), a different policy will apply. All registered teams will receive a full credit of 100% of their registration fees. The Allstar Cheerleading Championships will work to reschedule the event if possible. If a reschedule date is not feasible, the credit can be used for any future event. If The Allstar Cheerleading Championships cancels an event and it is not rescheduled, your team will receive a full credit of 100% of their registration fees.

Communication of Weather-Related Changes will occur on the Official Website, Social Media (Facebook and Instagram) as well as Email and Text notifications to the contacts listed on the account. Please keep an eye on the local and national weather forecasts so that you are prepared for any inclement weather.
