Cheer Bids

- Event offering 4 At Large Bids Only

 - At Large #2 – Next Highest Score in the combined prep cheer qualifying divisions
 - At Large #3 – Highest Score in the combined competitive rec qualifying divisions
 - Exception: If there are no Competitive Rec Teams Registered for the event, the bid is awarded to the next highest score of all Prep/Rec Divisions
 - At Large #4 - Highest Score in the Combined Allstar Rec qualifying divisions
 - Exception: If there are no All Star Rec Teams registered for the event, the bid is awarded to the next highest score of all Prep/Rec Divisions

Dance Bids

Events offering 1 At Large Bid

- At Large Bid #1- Highest Score in the combined Dance divisions
 - Exception: If there are no Prep/Rec dance teams registered for the event, the bid goes away and can not be used for cheer divisions.
