Event offering 1 Paid Cheer Bid & 8 At Large Cheer Bids - **Live/In Person Events**

- Paid Bid – Highest Score of event for all qualifying divisions
- At Large 1, 2, 3, 4– Highest scores in the combined Mini/Youth qualifying divisions
- At Large 5, 6, 7, 8 – Highest scores in the combined Junior/Senior qualifying divisions

Event offering 2 Paid Cheer Bids & 12 At Large Cheer Bids - **Live/In Person Events**

- Paid Bid #1 – Highest Score of event for all qualifying divisions
- Paid Bid #2 – Next Highest Score of event for all qualifying divisions
- At Large 1, 2, 3, 4– Highest scores in the combined Mini/Youth qualifying divisions
- At Large 5, 6, 7, 8 – Highest scores in the combined Junior/Senior qualifying divisions
- At Large 9-12 – Next Highest score across all qualifying divisions

2. At Large #2 – Next Highest Score in the combined Mini/Youth qualifying divisions
3. At Large #3 – Highest Score in the combined Junior/Senior/International qualifying divisions
4. At Large #4 – Next Highest Score in the combined Junior/Senior/International qualifying divisions

****If there are no eligible bid recipients in the division, bids will be passed to the next division**

Breaking Ties

Rule 1: Deductions - who has the least amount of deductions.

If deductions are the same:

Rule 2: Legalities - who has the least amount of legalities

If legalities are the same:

Rule 3: Building Choreography/Presentation highest score

If Building Choreography/Presentation is the same:

Rule 4: Stunt Difficulty (includes boosters) highest score

If all above rules are equal and tie still cannot be broken then it will stand as a tie.

Cheer Bids

- Event offering 4 Partial Paid Bids Only
 - Partial Paid #1 – Highest Score in the combined prep cheer qualifying divisions
 - Partial Paid #2 – Next Highest Score in the combined prep cheer qualifying divisions
 - Partial Paid #3 – Highest Score in the combined competitive rec qualifying divisions
 - Exception: If there are no Competitive Rec Teams Registered for the event, the bid is awarded to the next highest score of all Prep/Rec Divisions
 - Partial Paid #4 - Highest Score in the Combined Allstar Rec qualifying divisions
 - Exception: If there are no All Star Rec Teams registered for the event, the bid is awarded to the next highest score of all Prep/Rec Divisions

Dance (1) Partial Paid Dance Bid will be offered at All Events offering Allstar World Championship At Large Bids

1. Partial Paid #1- Highest Score in the combined Dance divisions

- Exception: If there are no Prep/Rec dance teams registered for the event, the bid goes away and can not be used for cheer divisions.

Breaking Ties

Rule 1: Deductions - who has the least amount of deductions.

If deductions are the same:

Rule 2: Building Choreography/Presentation highest score

If Building Choreography/Presentation is the same:

Rule 3: Stunt Difficulty (includes boosters) highest score

If all above rules are equal and tie still cannot be broken then it will stand as a tie
